Front facing roles include

- *First point of contact for our audience*
- *An information guru on our programme and site map*
- *The doorman*
- *Seating guests to their booths and seats*
- *Serving guests in booths with drinks*
- *Looking after the site as though it was their home*
- *Looking out for everyone on the site, inside & out*

Backstage roles include

- *Changing venue formations*
- *Effecting healthy and safety management of the site*
- *Ensuring the site and venues are presentable*
- *Manning doors and checking in with artists back stage*
- *Supporting the stage manager and technical crew when they need it!*
